


Relevance\_of\_project







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The above table shows attitude of students about the repository of books in the library. It can be inferred that 66.4% of students remarked as adequate which shows that the College library has ample books to read.






This analysis shows that 42.6% of students states that Calicut University is similar or equal to other universities and about 54.7 % of students states that our university is superior than other universities


The above table shows the Student -Teacher relationship in the College. From the data it is clear that half of the students are happy with the student- teacher relationship.




The data shows that three fourth of the students finds the College administrative office as helpful and the left respondents have a neutral opinion.
















